We are looking for a locum physician to cover a two year contract.

In addition to comprehensive primary care you will be providing primary HIV care to our patients who are living with HIV. Your colleagues will include Physicians, Nurse Practitioners, Registered Nurses, Dietititans, Therapists and Chiropody, as well as other allied health and community supports.

ACCOUNTABILITIES - KEY

- 1. Provide comprehensive primary HIV care.
- 2. Support access to a cascade of services inclusive of HIV treatment, support and care
- 3. Support HIV prevention needs of racialized women by facilitating access to PrEP and other biomedical HIV prevention strategies
- 4. Perform assessment, diagnosis, treatment, health education/counselling, and other medical functions as required according to the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario standards of practice.
- 5. Participate in the Centre's on-call service as needed
- 6. Contribute to the development, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of medical protocols and directives.
- 7. Contribute to chart documentation, participate in chart reviews and case conferences, and make referrals.
- 8. Participate in the development, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of treatment, education, counselling and health promotion programs and services for individuals, groups and the community.
- 9. Perform other duties as assigned.

- 1. Medical degree from a recognized university.
- 2. CCFP Certification or equivalent practical experiences, an asset.
- 3. License to practice from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.
